

VFPASNY “Woodman” Award

Fire Police Service Achievement

>>>> REQUEST FOR CANDIDATES <<<<

This individual needs to be an Active Fire Police Member of a Volunteer Fire Department, Company, or Squad. The Award shall be made on the merits, such as continued distinguished meritorious service to the Fire Police Community over a prolonged/extended period of years. This individual leads by example, by doing things. This person demonstrates total dedication to the fire police service and his/her community, including being a volunteer in other organizations.

The “RECOMMENDATION LETTERS OF SPECIFICS” must be:

1. signed by either the president, chief, or secretary of the recommending organization,
2. printed on the official stationery of the recommending organization,
3. mailed to the Chairman of the Awards Committee,
4. mailed using Certified Mail,
5. received by the Chairman by February 28th,

and should contain the following;

- name(s) of the candidate(s), title/rank, years of service,
- name of the fire department/company/squad,
- a personal history, including education, employment, and other related data,
- firematic service, including offices held and other assignments,
- community service, including volunteer organizations served,
- endorsement letters from the firematic service, community service organizations, and community leaders,
- information furnished should include the related years or actual dates served.

>>>> The Awards Committee will retain the “Letters” for unsuccessful candidates for a period of three years for the purpose of reconsideration. During this period the recommending organizations will be allowed to update the Recommendation Letter of Specifics.
